PIN Meeting Tuesday, March 14, 2017

Topics

- Dress Code Standards – Pants
- 6th Grade APEX Program

Dress Code Standards – Concerns with Section D. Slacks/Pants/Capris

- While the heading includes Capris, there is no definition of exactly what Capri means for Adams Traditional Academies dress code.
- Section D. 4) c) states “Should reach the shoe but not drag on the ground.” If pants must reach the shoe, then they cannot be a capri.
- Patch Pocket Issue
 - Illustration shows a patch pocket.
 - Section D. 1) states “Description – The classic Dockers™ look is our standard for our look and material style. Please see illustrations.
 - Appearance does not give any details to the back pockets.
- Administration has concerns because the style of pants that meet our fabric requirements with a patch pocket does not have a uniform appearance.

Parents recommendations include:

- Eliminate Capris from the Section D tile.
- Eliminate the diagram showing the patch pocket.
- Make all these dress standards effective for the 2017-2018 school year.
- Send a notice to parents in May 2017 informing them of the changes for next year.

6th Grade APEX Program

The 6th Grade Teachers would like to either change or discontinue the APEX program for 6th grade. At this level, they are finding that students are now usually strong in Math or Language, but seldom both. Some students are excelling in the preferred subject and then struggling in their more challenging subject.

Some recommendations included:

- Sort classes with one class focused on students who excel in math, one class focused on students who excel in Language and then the final class be the other students.
Parent Concerns Include:
 - What does that look like for the make-up of those classes?
 - What would the third class look like?
- To eliminate APEX program and sort the classes with the normal sorting process.

It was noted if there is a change to the program, the Handbook would need to be updated.

ATA PTO Council Meeting - March 7, 2017

The meeting was called to order at 5:30pm. Members in attendance were Sandy Thompson, Debbie Parker, Christie Murphy, Jamie Grange, Mirna Dahdal, Tabitha Voss-Wall, and Nicole Pease. Absent members were Chris Cowell, Jamie Finn, Natasha Woolery and Heidi Granatelli. Administration was represented by Mrs. Schorer and Mrs. Wilson-Smith.

Financials:

- Current account starting balance \$39,494.51, less the following earmarked expenses.
 - Taxes \$4,000
 - Playground \$10,000
 - \$25,494.51 Account Ending Balance, pending other expenses
- 8th Grade 2016-2017 Account Balance \$2,677.44 (43 students x \$50 – fees)
- Current bylaws state that PTO must turn over all but 10% of the account balance at the end of the school year to ATA. Sandy is requesting Admin to allow PTO to keep more than this due to the Apex Fun Run currently scheduled in September. The contract with Apex prohibits any additional fundraising by PTO for several months leading up to and after the fun run, so PTO would be unable to plan any of the usual activities (i.e. Fall Festival) since there would not be enough money in the account.

Operations:

- Taxes: Our tax person has been hard to reach. PTO should consider finding a new tax person. Several people had recommendations.
 - 2014 taxes: He wrote a letter to the IRS regarding the taxes that were not filed for 2014. We are still waiting for a response.
 - 2016 taxes were due Nov. 2016. An extension was filed until the end of February. We are now past this date and Mirna has made repeated attempts to reach him to find out status. He finally replied (after the deadline) saying that it “shouldn’t be a problem” filing late.
- Succession: The following council members will not be returning next year: Natasha, Debbie, Heidi, Sandy, and Jamie Finn. That leaves six returning members.
 - The question was asked if PTO is limited to Parents/Teachers only? Our bylaws say parents/guardians so anyone who is the legal guardian is eligible. Otherwise no.
- Volunteer hours are not used for grants, but they are necessary for the annual audit.
 - Remind parents to check into matching funds from employers for volunteering.

Updates:

- Box Tops/Campbells: Box Tops raised \$449.20. We also received 2701 points for Labels for Education. Points can be used to purchase items such as basketballs and art supplies.
 - This led to a discussion on purchasing balls for the school and someone brought up Dicks Sporting Goods program to get balls. Jamie G. will follow up with Dicks.
- Book Fair/Grands Breakfast/Art Fair: Volunteers desperately needed! We need to do another email and phone blast and also stress that the Grands breakfast is free.
- Talent Show: Forms are due 3/17, auditions will be 3/27, & the show will be 6pm 4/7. Madison needs judges for the auditions, 3 per room, total of 3 rooms, and another room for prep. Estimated budget is \$260 which reflects the additional trophies. This year there are two division for music and dance, with prizes 1-3 in each.
 - QuickTrophyOnline.com was mentioned as a possible trophy resource.

Calendar Update/Changes:

- Citizenship Lunch: Jamie G will take over as lead with Tabitha assisting. It will be limited to one student per class. Council members present voted to host the lunch in the Opportunity Club classroom with pizza, salad, and cake to reduce costs.
- Honor Roll Field Trip: PTO has discussed all year options to change things up a little. Ultimately, it was decided that Amazing Jake’s was preferred for many reasons for Grades 3 & 4. Sandy will follow up with Wet n’ Wild to price out taking Grades 5-8 there. This was approved by 6 out of 6 members present.
- Year End Party(ies): Due to Administration concerns PTO will not be hosting a general year end party and will instead have HRP’s coordinate classroom parties as in the past. An email needs to go out to the HRP’s soon about this.
- Eighth Grade Dinner and Dance: The event will be 5/12 and the theme is New York. StuGo and 7th grade will be responsible for setup.

Misc:

- Admin is requesting that PTO fund teacher gifts next year. They are requesting an amount not to exceed \$100/teacher/school year. If Admin gives gifts directly they would be taxable. Council members present voted to approve. Cards would specify “given by PTO on behalf of the administration” or similar wording.
- PTO Bulletin Board: The current location receives very little foot traffic so PTO would like to move it closer to the front double doors. Another suggestion was to move it back to the old location outside of Mrs. Fulmer’s room, and she could use what is now the Cub Scout Board. A new board could be built for Cub Scouts further down the hallway.
