 - **PIN committee** (Parent Information Night): Responsibilities include sending out monthly email for items to be discussed and running the PIN meeting each month. It is usually held the Tues before the Site Council meeting (for Adams....JP has never been able to get this one going so this last month we sent out a feedback opportunity through the JP newsletter) This committee can require extra time or no time at all. We didn't have one PIN meeting last year but we already have a parent asking for one this year so I need someone asap (I will help with this until it gets up and going). We need one parent from each school.
 - **Bi-law committee:** We have to review and combine the bi laws from each school and make Choice Academies Bi laws. I will need 2 parents and 2 teachers to help read through both sets of bi laws and find the similarities and the difference and then make a

proposal to bring to the council on Choice Academies Bi Laws. The goal for this is to be done by February. It will require reading and meetings between the committee outside of the regular Site Council meetings.
